FINDINGS AND ORDERS

The above entitled matter having been heard and regularly submitted, the Honorable Jeffrey Morgan, Workers' Compensation Administrative Law Judge, now decides as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Manuel Lorenzana, born on 1/1/52, while employed during the period commencing 1/8/06 through 3/21/11 as a machine operator, at Camarillo, California, by, American International Industries and Aftermarket Acquisitions, whose workers' compensation insurance carriers were Ace Property and Casualty, and The Hartford,, sustained injury arising out of and occurring in the course of employment to his cervical spine and left wrist..
2. Lien Claimant Ortho Therapeutics did not provide medical treatment reasonably required to cure or relieve from the effects of the industrial injury herein.
3. Lien Claimant Nosrat Javidian M.D. did not provide medical treatment reasonably required to cure or relieve from the effects of the industrial injury herein.
