9	DISPOSITION:
	The matter will stand submitted.
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1	OPINION OF JUDGE ON DECISION
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3	The facts as reflected in the MSC statement and in the Minutes of Hearing are adopted and incorporated as Findings of Fact.
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5	More specifically, it was stipulated that decedent, Lewis Cisneros, sustained injury arising out of and in the course of his employment on September 8, 2008, and he passed
6	away on September 9, 2013.
7	The undersigned wishes to emphasize that the only issue the undersigned is deciding is whether or not the dependency
8	claim is barred by the Statute of Limitations. The issue of inter vivos benefits, if any, or the lien of Dr. Moelleken,
9	are not being decided.
10	The undersigned considers the case of Massey v. WCAB (1993) 5 Cal.4th 674, 58 CCC 367, to be dispositive of this
11	issue. Simply put, the case is barred by the Statute of Limitations.
12	In this case the Company Count held that it is a
13	In this case, the Supreme Court held that it is a condition precedent before dependency benefits may be awarded that the decedent died within 240 weeks of the injury. The
14	decedent in this case passed away beyond that time period and, therefore, the case is barred by the Statute of Limitations.
