DA: Former school janitor pleads guilty to workers' comp fraud

FAIRFIELD - A longtime school janitor with the Travis School District pleaded guilty Oct. 9 to a felony workers' compensation fraud charge, according to a press release issued Wednesday by the Solano County District Attorney's Office.

Damon A. Fraticelli had been a school district employee for more than 25 years in April 2013 when he claimed he injured his right shoulder and that the injury was so severe he could only wipe and clean tables with his left hand. After filing a workers' compensation claim form, Fraticelli on April 1, 2013, told a doctor about the severe pain. He was filmed the next day bowling with his right arm for nearly 40 minutes.

Fraticelli's name appeared three weeks later in the local newspaper, touting his recent bowling scores.

Judge Robert Bowers placed Fraticelli on five years of formal probation, ordered him to pay \$10,000 and to perform community service hours.
