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1 SUMMARY OF EVIDENCE 2 ADRIANA MELENDREZ, was called as a witness by Defendant on her own behalf, sworn, and testified substantially as follows: Direct Examination by Mr. Adil: She was evaluated by Willard Wong and was referred there by Dr. Mittal at WorkWell. She 5 obtained the report from Dr. Wong yesterday. She picked it up herself. She does have low back pain with symptoms that go into her legs, the right leg mostly, and some into her left leg. The leg pain goes into her toes. She feels pain differently 8 in different parts of her leq. When she sits, the pain is in the front of the leg and also behind her leg. 9 10 Dr. Wong did not recommend that she have surgery. He did not say whether she needed surgery in the future. She has seen 11 several doctors at WorkWell and two or three of them said she may have to have surgery further down the line. They gave her 12 different options over time. 13 She saw Dr. Wong in early December. She saw Dr. Wong on 14 December 6th and then Dr. Panchal on December 7th. appointments were made for her by WorkWell. 15 Dr. Panchal has not recommended surgery or that she be seen by 16 another orthopedist.
