Further adding value to his service to clients, Mr. Larres is the founder and head of Bradford & Barthel's Appellate Practice Division. Mr. Larres has been involved in several important appellate decisions. He was the lead author of the briefs (WCAB briefs, both writs and petition for review to the Supreme Court) in Guzman v. Milpitas Unified School District (Almaraz/Guzman I and II), which prompted him to open the firm's appellate division. Since then, he has argued numerous cases before the various courts of appeal (see Meadowbrook Ins. Co. V. Workers' Comp. Appeals Bd. (2019) 42 Cal. App. 5th 432, Star Ins. Co. v. Workers' Comp. Appeals Bd. (2016) 81 Cal.Comp.Cases 111, Kroger Co. v. Workers' Comp. Appeals Bd., (2012) 210 Cal. 4th 952, and Coca-Cola Enterprises Inc., v. Workers' Comp. Appeals Bd. (2011) 194 Cal.App.4th 809), and even the Supreme Court (South Coast Framing, Inc., (2015) 61 Cal.4th 291).
